NOTES TO THE CONSOLIDATED UNAUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the period from 1 January 2025 to 30 June 2025

1. Incorporation and principal activities

Country of incorporation

The Company Medscope Holdings PLC (the "Company") was incorporated in Cyprus on 9 December 2009 as a private limited liability company under the provisions of the Cyprus Companies Law, Cap. 113. Its registered office is at 11 Kyriakou Matsi Street, NIKIS CENTER, 8th floor, 1082 Nicosia, Cyprus. On 14 September 2021, the Company became a public company under the Companies Law, Cap. 113 and on 20 April 2022 its shares were listed on the Cyprus Stock Exchange, Emerging Markets.

The Company wholly owns (100%) and controls the Subsidiary, World Properties S.R.L., which is registered in Romania and operates under the laws of Romania and is active in the field of real estate investing and operating real estate. The Subsidiary was incorporated on December 15, 2021 as a Limited Liability Company under the laws of Romania.

The Company, on June 7, 2023, acquired the 60% and controls the subsidiary, Brasov Renewables S.R.L., which is registered in Romania and operates under the laws of Romania and is active in the field of real estate investing and operating real estate. The Subsidiary was incorporated on June 7, 2023 as a Limited Liability Company under the laws of Romania.

On August 22, 2024, Octopus Properties Single Member S.A. ("Octopus") was incorporated in Greece and issued 250 shares with a nominal value of €100 each. All shares were purchased by the Company on October 15, 2024. On December 10, 2024, Octopus proceeded with the increase of its issued share capital by 2.000 shares with a nominal value of €100 each. All new shares were acquired by the Company.

The Company, on June 19, 2025, acquired 100% and controls the Subsidiary, Square Properties S.R.L., which is registered in Romania and operates in accordance with the laws of Romania and is active in the real estate sector with real estate investments and exploitation. The Subsidiary was established on May 22, 2025 as a Limited Liability Company under the laws of Romania.

The Company, on June 30, 2025, acquired 60% and controls the Subsidiary, Vlasiei Renewables S.R.L., which is registered in Romania and operates in accordance with the laws of Romania and is active in the real estate sector with real estate investments and exploitation. The Subsidiary was established on June 20, 2025 as a Limited Liability Company under the laws of Romania.

The company also owns 50% in the associate company Corner Properties S.R.L. which is registered in Romania and operates under the Romanian laws and is active in the real estate sector with real estate investment and exploitation. In addition, the company owns 32,63% in associate company Vista Leasing IFN (Romania) S.A., which is registered in Romania and operates under the Romanian laws and and whose main activities are the provision of financial leasing and loan facilities. Vista Leasing IFN (Romania) S.A. was acquired during the year under review as described in note 13.

Unaudited financial statements

The consolidated financial statements for the six months ended on 30 June 2025 and 30 June 2024 respectively, have not been audited by the external auditors of the Company.

Principal activities

The Medscope Holdings PLC Group consists of Medscope Holdings PLC ("Company"), World Properties S.R.L., Brasov Renewables S.R.L. and Octopus Properties Single Member S.A., Square Properties S.R.L. and Vlasiei Renewables S.R.L. ("Subsidiaries") and associate companies. The principal activities of the Company are the holding of investments and the provision of finance to related companies. The principal activity of the Subsidiaries is the investment and exploitation of real estate.

NOTES TO THE CONSOLIDATED UNAUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the period from 1 January 2025 to 30 June 2025

2. Basis of preparation

These consolidated financial statements have been prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs) as adopted by the European Union (EU) and the requirements of the Cyprus Companies Law, Cap. 113. These consolidated financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of and investment property.

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with IFRSs requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates and requires Management to exercise its judgment in the process of applying the Group's accounting policies. It also requires the use of assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Although these estimates are based on Management's best knowledge of current events and actions, actual results may ultimately differ from those estimates.

3. Adoption of new or revised standards and interpretations

During the current period the Group adopted all the new and revised International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) that are relevant to its operations and are effective for accounting periods beginning on 1 January 2025. This adoption did not have a material effect on the accounting policies of the Group.

4. Significant accounting policies

The consolidated financial statements, which are presented in Euro, have been prepared in accordance with international Financial Reporting Standards, including IAS 34 "Interim Financial Reporting"

The accounting policies used in the preparation of the consolidated financial statements are in accordance with those used in the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024.

Costs that are incurred during the financial year are anticipated or deferred for interim reporting purposes if, and only if, it is also appropriate to anticipate or defer that type of cost at the end of the financial year.

Corporation tax is calculated based on the expected tax rates for the whole financial year.

These consolidated financial statements must be read in conjunction with the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024.

5. New accounting pronouncements

At the date of approval of these consolidated financial statements, standards and interpretations were issued by the International Accounting Standards Board which were not yet effective. Some of them were adopted by the European Union and others not yet. The Board of Directors expects that the adoption of these accounting standards in future periods will not have a material effect on the consolidated financial statements of the Group.

The Group operates in three tax jurisdictions and is subject to tax at the rates applicable in the respective countries of tax residence, the Republic of Cyprus, Romania and Greece. The tax rates for the Group are currently 12.5% in the Republic of Cyprus, 16% in Romania and 22% in Greece.

Under certain conditions interest income may be subject to defence contribution at the rate of 30%. In such cases this interest will be exempt from corporation tax. In certain cases, dividends received from abroad may be subject to defence contribution at the rate of 17%.

Gains on disposal of qualifying titles (including shares, bonds, debentures, rights thereon etc) are exempt from Cyprus income tax.

The Company held since 2020 a total of 3.263 shares of €1 each in the issued share capital of Barniveld Enterprises Corp. Limited ("Barniveld"). The shares were acquired by the Company at a total cost of €552.263. Barniveld Enterprises Corp. Limited held 99,99% of the issued share capital of Vista Leasing IFN (Romania) S.A., a company incorporated in Romania.

On 30 July 2024, the shareholders of Barniveld, by special resolution, resolved to reduce its issued share capital by 3.263 shares with a nominal value of €1 each. All the shares to be cancelled were held by Medscope Holdings plc. The reduction was ratified by the Nicosia District Court on 23 October 2024. On 13 November 2024, the board of directors of Barniveld resolved that Medscope Holdings plc, which was withdrawing from the share capital, would receive the following assets in return:

- 26.122.238 shares of Vista Leasing IFN (Romania) S.A. corresponding to 32,63% of its total issued share capital,
- subordinated loans receivable from Vista Leasing IFN (Romania) S.A., with a balance outstanding as at the date of transfer €1.468.350, and
- cash €340.000.

On 21 July 2022, the Company acquired 10 shares of LEI10 each in Corner Properties S.R.L., representing 50% of its issued share capital. The shares were acquired at their nominal value of LEI100 (equivalent to €20). On 22 July 2022, Corner Properties S.R.L. increased its issued share capital by issuing 1.580.800 new shares of LEI10 each. The Company acquired 790.400 shares with a nominal value of LEI7.904.000 (equivalent to €1.600.000), thus maintaining its ownership percentage. On 17 March 2023, Corner Properties S.R.L. further increased its issued share capital by issuing 738.000 new shares of LEI10 each. The Company acquired 369.000 shares with a nominal value of LEI3.690.000 (equivalent to €750.000), again maintaining its ownership percentage.

On 18 June 2021, the Company ("Lender") entered into a loan agreement with Vista Leasing IFN S.A. ("Borrower") for the provision of a loan in the total amount of €10.000.000 (which was increased to €15.000.000 with related additional agreement dated 6 December 2021 and to €20.000.000 with another related additional agreement dated 20 May 2022). The Borrower, based on the loan agreement, has the right to utilise the loan either in Euros or in United States Dollars (US\$). Until 30 June 2025, the Borrower utilised the total amounts of €13.100.000 and US\$8.770.000 which remain outstanding at 30 June 2025. The amount of the loan in Euro carries interest of three months EURIBOR plus a margin of 3% and the loan amount in United States Dollars carries interest at three months LIBORUS\$ plus a margin of 3% per annum. The amounts due are repayable until 18 June 2027.

22. Operating Environment of the

The geopolitical situation in Eastern Europe intensified on 24 February 2022 with the commencement of the conflict between Russia and Ukraine. As at the date of authorising these consolidated financial statements for issue, the conflict continues to evolve as military activity proceeds. In addition to the impact of the events on entities that have operations in Russia, Ukraine, or Belarus or that conduct business with their counterparties, the conflict is increasingly affecting economies and financial markets globally and exacerbating ongoing economic challenges.

The European Union as well as United States of America, Switzerland, United Kingdom and other countries imposed a series of restrictive measures (sanctions) against the Russian and Belarussian government, various companies, and certain individuals. The sanctions imposed include an asset freeze and a prohibition from making funds available to the sanctioned individuals and entities. In addition, travel bans applicable to the sanctioned individuals prevents them from entering or transiting through the relevant territories. The Republic of Cyprus has adopted the United Nations and European Union measures. The rapid deterioration of the conflict in Ukraine may as well lead to the possibility of further sanctions in the future.

22. Operating Environment of the (continued)

Emerging uncertainty regarding global supply of commodities due to the conflict between Russia and Ukraine conflict may also disrupt certain global trade flows and place significant upwards pressure on commodity prices and input costs as seen through early March 2022. Challenges for companies may include availability of funding to ensure access to raw materials, ability to finance margin payments and heightened risk of contractual non-performance.

The Israel-Gaza conflict has escalated significantly after Hamas launched a major attack on 7 October 2023. Companies with material subsidiaries, operations, investments, contractual arrangements or joint ventures in the War area might be significantly exposed. Entities that do not have direct exposure to Israel and Gaza Strip are likely to be affected by the overall economic uncertainty and negative impacts on the global economy and major financial markets arising from the war. This is a volatile period and situation, however, the is not directly exposed. Management will continue to monitor the situation closely and take appropriate actions when and if needed.

The impact on the largely depends on the nature and duration of uncertain and unpredictable events, such as further military action, additional sanctions, and reactions to ongoing developments by global financial markets.

The financial effect of the current crisis on the global economy and overall business activities cannot be estimated with reasonable certainty at this stage, due to the pace at which the conflict prevails and the high level of uncertainties arising from the inability to reliably predict the outcome.

The Group has no direct exposure to Russia, Ukraine, and Belarus and as such does not expect significant impact from direct exposures to these countries.

Management has considered the unique circumstances and the risk exposures of the and has concluded that there is no significant impact in the 's profitability position. The event is not expected to have an immediate material impact on the business operations.

23. Related party balances and transactions

The Company is controlled by Mr. Venetsianos Kakkavas, a non-tax resident of Cyprus, who owns 99.98% of the Company's shares.

26. Events after the reporting period

Depending on the duration of the conflict between Russia and Ukraine, the Israel-Gaza conflict and continued negative impact on economic activity, the might experience further negative results, and liquidity restraints and incur additional impairments on its assets in 2026 which relate to new developments that occurred after the reporting period.

Except from the matters mentioned above, there were no other material events after the reporting period, which have a bearing on the understanding of the consolidated financial statements.
